JINDAL BEGINS WORK IN CHHATTISGARH

New Delhi: The construction work will now start on 2400 MW power plant of Jindal Power Limited, (JPL) at Tamnar Chhattisgarh. This project was to come up by March, 2012 but was delayed as Environmental Clearances (EC), the project was delayed for more than one and half years. The environment ministry had granted Environmental Clearance (EC) for two units of 600MW each of the Expansion project of 2400MW (4x600 MW) of JPL at Tamnar, in March and granted EC for balance two units of 600 MW on 4th November .
