1.0 JPL invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Distribution Transformers required for Construction Power for 1000 MW (4X250MW) Raigarh Thermal Power Project situated in Tamnar, District Raigarh, State of Chhattisgarh, India, as per the scope of work mentioned herein after.

2.0 **Scope of Work :- The brief scope of Work is as under:**

Design, manufacture, assembly, testing at manufacture's works, packing, forwarding, supply & delivery of 9 no. 3 MVA 33/0.433 KV Distribution Transformers, 2 no. 500 KVA 33/0.433 KV Distribution Transformers & 2 no. 250 KVA 33/0.433 KV Distribution Transformers including transportation and transit insurance, complete with all accessories and spares including supervision of erection, testing & Commissioning of above said transformers at Site for efficient and trouble free operation of establishment of construction power for 4 X 250 MW Thermal Power Plant at Raigarh for Jindal Power Limited (JPL).

3.0 Qualifying requirement, benefits/ exemptions to supplies for this package as per provisions of Government of India Notifications for Mega Power Project, Cost of bidding documents and requirements regarding Bid security etc are elaborated below:

5.0 All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security for an amount equivalent to Indian Rs.2,50,000 (Rupees two hundred fifty thousand only), either in bid currency or in US Dollars. If the Bid Price is quoted in more than one currency, the Bid Security shall be in US Dollars. Bids not accompanied by the requisite Bid Security in a separate sealed envelope or bids accompanied by the Bid Security of inadequate value shall not be entertained and in such cases, bids shall be returned to the Bidders without being opened.

6.0 Benefits/Exemptions to suppliers for Mega Power Projects

Ministry of Power (Govt. of India) has certified in principle that 1000 MW Raigarh Thermal Power Project (4 X 250 MW) fulfils the laid down criteria for Mega Power Project. Accordingly, supplies of goods for this package will be eligible for benefits/ exemptions as per provisions of relevant notifications of the Govt. of India.

7.0 Qualifying requirement for Bidders

In addition to the requirement stipulated in Clause 13.2.1(e) under Part-B, Instruction to Bidders(ITB), Section-I-Condition of Contract of Bid Documents, the Bidder should also meet the qualifying requirement stipulated hereunder:

- I) The Bidder should be a manufacturer of transformer of this rating or above rating.
- II) The Bidder should have designed, manufactured, assembled, tested at their works at least thirty distribution transformers of similar rating or higher capacity and type, which should be in

successful operation for at least five years as on date of bid opening.

- III) The Bidder should have already type tested this rated or higher rating transformers.
- IV) The Bidder should have the facility to conduct the testing of the transformer as specified in Technical Specification at their own workshop facilities or should be able to conduct the testing in any outside agencies as per Owners choice.
- V) The average turn over of the Bidder in transformer business during the preceding three completed financial years as on date of the bid opening shall not be less than Indian Rs.25 crores.

8.0 JPL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the Invitation for Bids (IFB) without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no Bidder/intending Bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.

9.0 A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by any interested Bidder on submission of written application and payment (non-refundable) of the cost of the documents as mentioned at clause 4 above in the form of a crossed Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Jindal Power Limited payable at New Delhi. Issuance of Bidding Documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such Bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted and opened at the address given in clause 4 above in the presence of Bidder's representative who choose to attend.
