1.0 JPL invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Ash Handling System required for 1000 MW (4X250MW) Raigarh Thermal Power Project situated in Tamnar, District Raigarh, State of Chhattisgarh, India, as per the scope of work mentioned herein after.

2.0 Scope of Work:- The brief scope of Work is as under:

Design, engineering, manufacture, testing at manufacturer's works, assembly, packing, forwarding, supply and delivery of complete Ash Handling System & auxiliaries consisting of Bottom Ash Handling System (Jet pump evacuation system in conjunction with water impounded bottom ash hopper), vacuum/ pneumatic fly ash conveying system for ash conveying from fly ash hoppers to Intermediate Surge Hopper, pneumatic fly ash transportation system for ash conveying from Intermediate Surge Hopper to main Silo, slurry pumping system for ash slurry conveying from slurry sumps to ash dyke etc. including transportation and transit insurance, spares, tools & tackles including erection, testing, commissioning and PG Testing of above mentioned equipments and supervision of civil works (execution of civil works at Site is not included in this package) as per specification and scope defined in Bid Documents.

3.0 Qualifying requirement, benefits/ exemptions to supplies for this package as per provisions of Government of India Notifications for Mega Power Project, Cost of bidding documents and requirements regarding Bid security etc are elaborated below:

5.0 All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security for an amount equivalent to Indian Rs.10,00,000.00 (Rupees Ten lacs only), either in bid currency or in US Dollars in the form of Bank Guarantee as per the Performa of Bid Guarantee attached in Section-I, Conditions of Contract of Bid documents. If the Bid Price is quoted in more than one currency, the Bid Security shall be in US Dollars. Bids not accompanied by the requisite Bid Security in a separate sealed envelope or bids accompanied by the Bid Security of inadequate value shall not be entertained and in such cases, bids shall be returned to the Bidders without being opened.

6.0 Benefits/Exemptions to suppliers for Mega Power Projects

Ministry of Power (Govt. of India) has certified in principle that 1000 MW Raigarh Thermal Power Project (4 X 250 MW) fulfils the laid down criteria for Mega Power Project. Accordingly, supplies of goods for this package will be eligible for benefits/ exemptions as per provisions of relevant notifications of the Govt. of India.

7.0 Qualifying requirement for Bidders

7.1 In addition to the requirement stipulated in Clause 13.2.1 (e) under Part-B, Instruction to Bidders (ITB), the Bidder should also meet the qualifying requirement stipulated hereunder:

- A. The Bidder should have designed, engineered, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned Bottom Ash Handling System (Jet pump evacuation system in conjunction with water impounded bottom ash hopper) in atleast 2 pulverized fuel fired power stations of minimum capacity of 200 MW which should be in successful operation for atleast last 2 years at the time of Bid opening.**

AND

- B. The Bidder should have designed, engineered, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned vacuum/ pneumatic fly ash conveying system for ash conveying from fly ash hoppers to Intermediate Surge Hopper in atleast 2 pulverized fuel fired power stations of minimum capacity of 200 MW which should be in successful operation for atleast 2 years at the time of Bid opening.**

AND

- C. The Bidder should have designed, engineered, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned pneumatic fly ash transportation system for ash conveying from Intermediate Surge Hopper to main Silo for minimum distance of 500 meters in atleast 2 pulverized fuel fired power stations of minimum capacity of 200 MW which should be in successful operation for atleast 2 years at the time of Bid opening.**

AND

- D. The Bidder should have designed, engineered, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned slurry pumping system for ash slurry conveying from slurry sumps to ash dyke for minimum distance of 500 meters in atleast 2 pulverized fuel fired power stations of minimum capacity of 200 MW which should be in successful operation for atleast 2 years at the time of Bid opening.**

AND

- E. The average turnover of the Bidder in the preceding three financial years (2002 – 2003, 2003 – 2004 & 2004 – 2005) should not be less than Rs. 25.00 Crores at the time of Bid opening. If the average turnover of the Bidder in the preceding three financial years is less than Rs. 25.00 Crores at the time of Bid opening, however, his Principle average turnover is more than Rs. 25.00 Crores in the preceding three financial years, in such case, the Bidder is qualified subject to the condition that his Principle will provide a joint undertaking of successful execution of this project and shall provide additional Contract Performance Guarantee of 5% over and above the Contract Performance Guarantee to be submitted by the Bidder as per the terms and conditions indicated in Section – I titled “Conditions of Contract” of Bid Specifications.**
- F. For the purpose of qualification, the experience indicated at clause no. A, B, C, D & E above at separate plants are also permissible.**

- 7.2 If the Bidder does not fulfill the conditions stipulated in clause no. 7.1 A, B, C & D above, however, his Principle/ valid collaborator at the time of bid**

opening meets the requirement of clause 7.1 A, B, C & D above, in such case, the Bidder is considered to be qualified subject to the condition that his Principle/ valid collaborator will provide a joint undertaking of successful execution of this project and shall provide additional Corporate Guarantee over and above the Contract Performance Guarantee to be submitted by the Bidder as per the terms and conditions indicated in Section – I titled “Conditions of Contract” of Bid Specifications.

- 7.3** If the Bidder does not fulfil all the conditions stipulated under clause 7.1 above, in such case, he may form a Joint Venture with one or more Bidder/ Bidders who must meet the qualifying requirement for the components they are designated to perform. However, each partner of the Joint Venture should fulfill the turnover requirement indicated in clause 7.1 E above. In respect of Joint venture, the bidders are requested to follow the conditions indicated in clause 13.2 (e) of Part – B, Conditions of Contract, Section – I of Bidding Documents.
- 8.0** JPL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the Invitation for Bids (IFB) without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no Bidder/intending Bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 9.0** A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by any interested Bidder on submission of written application and payment (non-refundable) of the cost of the documents as mentioned at clause 4 above in the form of a crossed Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Jindal Power Limited payable at New Delhi. Issuance of Bidding Documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such Bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted and opened at the address given in clause 4 above in the presence of Bidder’s representative who choose to attend.
