1.0 JPL invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for complete civil, structural and architectural works for 1000 MW (4X250MW) Raigarh Thermal Power Project situated in Tamnar, District Raigarh, State of Chhattisgarh, India, as per the scope of work mentioned herein after.

2.0 **Scope of Work :- The brief scope of Work is as under:**

Execution of complete civil, structural and architectural works of main plant building, Cooling tower, Pump houses, workshop building, Pre-treatment and DM Plant building, auxiliary buildings, piling, foundations of all the equipments including mobilizing, supply of materials, manpower, equipments tools and tackles and consumable required for all civil, structural and architectural works for 4 X 250 MW Thermal Power Plant at Raigarh for Jindal Power Limited (JPL).

3.0 Qualifying requirement, benefits/ exemptions to supplies for this package as per provisions of Government of India Notifications for Mega Power Project, Cost of bidding documents and requirements regarding Bid security etc are elaborated below:

5.0 All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security for an amount equivalent to Indian Rs.80,000,000 (Rupees Eighty Million only), either in bid currency or in US Dollars as per the performa of Bid Guarantee attached in Section-I, Condition of Contract of Bid Documents. If the Bid Price is quoted in more than one currency, the Bid Security shall be in US Dollars. Bids not accompanied by the requisite Bid Security in a separate sealed envelope or bids accompanied by the Bid Security of inadequate value shall not be entertained and in such cases, bids shall be returned to the Bidders without being opened.

6.0 Benefits/Exemptions to suppliers for Mega Power Projects

Ministry of Power (Govt. of India) has certified in principle that 1000 MW Raigarh Thermal Power Project (4 X 250 MW) fulfils the laid down criteria for Mega Power Project. Accordingly, supplies of goods for this package will be eligible for benefits/ exemptions as per provisions of relevant notifications of the Govt. of India.

7.0 Qualifying requirement for Bidders

In addition to the requirement stipulated in Clause 13.2.1 (e) under Part-B, Instruction to Bidders(ITB) of Section- I: Condition of Contract, the Bidder should also meet the qualifying requirement stipulated hereunder:

i) The average turn over of the bidder during the preceding three completed financial years as on date of the bid opening shall not be less than Indian Rupees 200 Crores.

And

ii) The bidder must have experience of executing similar works in atleast 2 (two) power plant in last five years.

And

iii) The bidder must have executed single contract of similar work of value of around 25 Crores (Rupees Twenty Five Crore), excluding cost of cement, reinforcement steel & Structural steel in last five years.

Or

The bidder must have executed two contracts of similar work with value of each contract around Rs.20 Crores (Rupees Twenty Crore), excluding cost of cement, reinforcement steel & Structural steel in last five years.

- 8.0 JPL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the Invitation for Bids (IFB) without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no Bidder/intending Bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 9.0 A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by any interested Bidder on submission of written application and payment (non-refundable) of the cost of the documents as mentioned at clause 4.0 above in the form of a **crossed Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Jindal Power Limited payable at New Delhi**. Issuance of Bidding Documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such Bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted and opened at the address given in clause 4 above in the presence of Bidder's representative who choose to attend.
