1.0 Jindal Power Limited (JPL) invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for 415V PCC/PMCC/MCC/DIST. BOARDS and L.T. BUS DUCTS Package for 1000 MW (4 x 250 MW) Raigarh Thermal Power Project situated at Tamnar, District Raigarh, State of Chhattisgarh, India, as per the scope of work mentioned herein after.

2.0 **Scope of Work:**

The brief Scope of Work is as under:

Design, Engineering, Manufacture, Assembly, Testing at manufacture's works including Type Test, Packing & forwarding, Supply, Delivery at Site including Transportation & Transit insurance and Supervision of Erection, Testing & Commissioning of approx. 1,200 vertical panels of 415V PCC/PMCC/MCC /DIST. BOARDS and approx. 200 Mtr. of L.T. BUS DUCTS complete with fittings and accessories including supply of spares, maintenance tools & tackles as per specification and scope defined in Bidding Documents.

3.0 Qualifying requirement, benefits / exemptions to supplies for this package as per provisions of Government of India Notifications for Mega Power Project, Cost of bidding documents and requirements regarding Bid security etc are elaborated below:

5.0 All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security for an amount equivalent to Indian Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh only), either in bid currency or in US Dollars in the form of Bank Guarantee as per the Performa of Bid Guarantee attached in Section-I, “ Conditions of Contract” of Bid Documents. If the Bid Price is quoted in more than one currency, the Bid Security shall be in US Dollars. Bids not accompanied by the requisite Bid Security in a separate sealed envelope or bids accompanied by Bid Security of inadequate value shall not be entertained and in such cases, bids shall be returned to the Bidders without being opened..

6.0 **Benefits/Exemptions to suppliers for Mega Power Projects**

Ministry of Power (Govt. of India) has certified in principle that 1000 MW (4 x 250 MW) Raigarh Thermal Power Project fulfils the laid down criteria for Mega Power Project. Accordingly, supplies of goods for this package will be eligible for benefits/ exemptions as per provisions of relevant notifications of the Govt. of India.

7.0 **Qualifying requirement for Bidders**

In addition to the requirement stipulated under section Instruction to Bidders (ITB) of Bidding Documents the bidder should also meet the qualifying requirement stipulated hereunder:

A)

1) The Bidder should have manufactured, tested and supplied at least 7,500 vertical panels complete in all respects with fault rating of at least 50KA for 1 sec. and 105KA peak in last three (3) years prior to the date of bid opening.

AND

2) The Bidder should have tested switchgears suitable for 65KA for 1 sec. and 136KA peak. The type tests shall be carried out within last five (5) years from the date of bid opening.

AND

- 3) The Bidder should have designed, manufactured, tested and supplied at least 500 drawout panels complete in all respects with fault rating of 65KA for 1 sec. and 136KA peak and out of these, atleast 250 panels shall be in successful operation for a period of atleast two (2) years as on date of bid opening.

AND

- 4) The Bidder should be manufacture of Air Circuit Breakers, Moulded Case Circuit Breakers and Air Break Contractors.

AND

- 5) The average turnover of the Bidder shall not be less than INR 100 Crore per annum during preceding three (3) complete financial years (2002-03, 2003-04, and 2004-05) as on date of bid opening.

- B) If any bidder is not fulfilling the requirement indicated in A 1 to 4 above, but the bidder is qualifying requirement of A 5 above and have designed, manufactured and supplied 415V Switchboards and have manufacturing facilities for Switchboard and/or Switchgears in India based on technological support of its parent company or collaborator can also participate provided the parent company or collaborator meets the qualifying requirement stipulated at Points 1 to 4 above. In such a case, bidder shall furnish an undertaking jointly executed by him and his parent company or collaborator for the successful performance of the Contract. This joint deed of undertaking shall be submitted alongwith the bid, failing which the bidder shall be disqualified and his bid shall be rejected. In case of award, the parent company or collaborator will be required to furnish a Contract Performance Bank Guarantee for total 5% (five percent) of Contract price in addition to the Contract Performance Bank Guarantee to be furnished by the bidder as per the terms of “Conditions of Contract”.

8.0 JPL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for Bids (IFB) without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no Bidder / intending Bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.

9.0 A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by any interested Bidder on submission of written application and payment (non-refundable) of the cost of the documents as mentioned at clause 4 above in the form of a **Crossed Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Jindal Power Limited payable at New Delhi**. Issuance of Bidding Documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such Bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted and opened at the address given in clause 4.0 above in the presence of Bidder’s representative who choose to attend.
