- 1.0 JPL invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Pretreatment plant, Demineralisation plant and Cooling Water Treatment Plant with Accessories and auxiliaries for 1000 MW (4X250MW) Raigarh Thermal Power Project situated in Tamnar, District Raigarh, State of Chhattisgarh, India, as per the scope of work mentioned herein after.**
- 2.0 Scope of Work :- The brief scope of Work is as under:
Design, Engineering, Manufacturing, Assembly, Procurement and testing at manufactures works, packing forwarding, supply and delivery duly packed for transportation, transit insurance, unloading at site, erection, testing, commissioning , PG test and supervision of civil works (Execution of civil work is not included in this package) of Pre treatment Plant (Consisting of 3 nos Clarifier of 1750m³/hr capacity each, 2 nos Cascade Aerator, 2 nos stilling chamber, 3 nos Flash mixture, 3 nos venturi flumes, Clarified water tank and vertical pumps along with accessories and auxiliaries), Demineralisation Plant (Consisting of 3 nos 100m³/hr DM chain each, Ultrafiltration along with accessories and auxiliaries) and Cooling Water Treatment plant (Consisting of 6 nos vacuum feed chlorinator 200kg/hr each, Acid dosing system and 20 nos Automatic Valveless gravity filter units of capacity 175 m³/hr each along with accessories and auxiliaries) etc. required for 4 X 250 MW Thermal Power Plant at Raigarh for Jindal Power Limited (JPL).**
- 3.0 Qualifying requirement, benefits/ exemptions to supplies for this package as per provisions of Government of India Notifications for Mega Power Project, Cost of bidding documents and requirements regarding Bid security etc are elaborated below:**

5.0 All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security for an amount equivalent to Indian Rs.1,000,000 (Rupees One Million only), either in bid currency or in US Dollars in the form of Bank Guarantee as per the performa of Bid Guarantee attached in Section-I, “Conditions of Contract” of Bid Documents. If the Bid Price is quoted in more than one currency, the Bid Security shall be in US Dollars. Bids not accompanied by the requisite Bid Security in a separate sealed envelope or bids accompanied by the Bid Security of inadequate value shall not be entertained and in such cases, bids shall be returned to the Bidders without being opened.

6.0 Benefits/Exemptions to suppliers for Mega Power Projects

Ministry of Power (Govt. of India) has certified in principle that 1000 MW Raigarh Thermal Power Project (4 X 250 MW) fulfils the laid down criteria for Mega Power Project. Accordingly, supplies of goods for this package will be eligible for benefits/ exemptions as per provisions of relevant notifications of the Govt. of India.

7.0 Qualifying requirement for Bidders

In addition to the requirement stipulated in Clause 13.2.1 (e) under Part-B, Instruction to Bidders(ITB) of Section- I: Condition of Contract, the Bidder should also meet the qualifying requirement stipulated hereunder:

The bidder should have designed, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned atleast 1 no. of Pre treatment plant consisting of clarifier of minimum capacity of 1500 M³/hr which should be in successful operation for atleast 1 year at the time of bid opening.

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The bidder should have designed, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned atleast 1 no. of DM Plant of minimum capacity of 100M³/hr which should be in successful operation for at least 2 years at the time of bid opening.

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The bidder should have designed, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned atleast 4 chains of Side Steam Filter of minimum capacity of 100 M³/hr each which should be in successful operation for at least 2 years at the time of bid opening.

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The bidder should have designed, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned atleast 2 nos. of Chlorination System of minimum capacity of 150 kg/hr each which should be in successful operation for atleast 2 years at the time of bid opening.

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The average turnover of the Prime bidder during the preceding three (3) financial years should not be less than Rs. 100 crores and the bidder should be a profit making organization.

If the bidder does not fulfill all the conditions stipulated above, in such case, he may form a Joint Venture (JV) with one or more bidder/ bidders who must meet the qualifying requirements for the component they are designated to perform. In respect of JV, the bidders are requested to follow the conditions indicated in Clause 13.2 (e) of Part-B of Conditions of Contract, Section - 1 of Bid Documents.

8.0 JPL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the Invitation for Bids (IFB) without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no Bidder/intending Bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.

9.0 A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by any interested Bidder on submission of written application and payment (non-refundable) of the cost of the documents as mentioned at clause 4.0 above in the form of a

crossed Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Jindal Power Limited payable at New Delhi. Issuance of Bidding Documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such Bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted and opened at the address given in clause 4 above in the presence of Bidder's representative who choose to attend.
